Due to several open spots for Educational Presentations advancing to State, we are holding a Spring Contest for Seniors only. This will be for the open spots in the designated categories below. Those that placed in Fall Big Fun in D1 will remain in their awarded position. This is a one-time opportunity and will not happen every year or for every contest.

Contest Format

• All Educational Presentations: will consist of individuals or teams of 2. Individuals/Teams shall give an illustrated talk or method demonstration on a selected topic for a max of 12 minutes. Posters, Power Points, and some props are acceptable. Refer to guidelines.

Open (3rd place) Swine (1st, 2nd & 3rd place)
